BEL AIR, Md., (Nov. 30, 2018) – Trappe Church Road in Darlington between Poole Road and MD Route 161 will be closed to repair flood damage to the bridge over Hollands Branch. The closure to all through traffic will begin on or about Monday, December 10, 2018 for the project, which will take approximately two months to complete.
