- **Donna Blasdell**, Legislative Aide to Councilman Mike Perrone, attended in Mr. Perrone’s absence. Alerted community to the coming medical marihuana dispensary on Route 40; Rise is the company. Citizens noted that there’s a methadone clinic in the community near McDonalds. Some concern about this; maybe invite company representative to a meeting to share.
- **Jake Adler**, Business Development Associate, Community and Economic Development:
  - BRAC Zone application in progress
  - SHA states work to Route 755 is complete
  - Route 40 planters are the responsibility of the County to maintain
  - Implementation Meeting set for Tuesday, February 13, 6 p.m. at the Southern Precinct
    - Citizens have voiced concerns about the Edgewood sign on Willoughby Beach Road; may be able to address during the meeting
    - Stressed need for citizen input; partnerships required to implement plan
- **Community Concerns:**
  - Edgewood Shopping Center – repairs. Previous attempts to get action from property owner (Dave Cordish) outlined; generally property owner is uncooperative.
  - Shopping Center near EPICENTER – what’s happening? Who owns?
  - Livability Code – may be a means for addressing absentee landlords
  - Expand vocational opportunities for youth
